

BFRC Open 50 metre Rifle Meeting 2019

Please read carefully

Due to the lack of range space and high demand each year we are again running 3 English Matches on the Saturday. You may enter 1 or 2 matches, but not all 3. The entry form asks you to put down your preference of detail(s) – please place 1 under your first choice, 2 under your second etc. I will try to give people their first preference, but there may have to be some second (or even third) choices allocated.

Due to range orientation if it at all sunny then side blinder restrictions will not apply for the first squad prone.

If you want to shoot both Air Rifle and Prone the obvious choice is EM1 and AR1/2 or EM1, AR1 and EM3 (but this will be a problem if you make AR and EM3 finals).

Currently we have to limit 50m range use to 35 firing points, leaving 5 for hospital bays. This gives a total of 105 slots again this year, so hopefully we will be able to accommodate everyone. We just made it last year!

For IPC shooters, if there is very high demand for prone we can still accommodate you, as in previous years, with you shooting separately when the EM1 and 2 finals are running. If there are enough of you we can run a final for you as well. Equally for Air Rifle, a specific IPC match could be added in the morning if demand is sufficient and a final run concurrent with the main air rifle final.

In previous years we have tried to accommodate late entries for the prone matches but so many people have left it late to enter it has become very difficult to organise so don't be surprised if your entry is returned or refused if it is near the deadline!

Notes: Prone rifle is **not** an aggregate competition. There will be a separate prize list for each match.

ISSF timings will apply to all events.

Equipment should comply with ISSF rules.

Exception on side blinders for squad 1 only
